COSTUME BALANCE & DISTRIBUTION

Costumes are arriving daily and are being prepared for distribution. This preparation requires many hours and details. Please remember that Morita's School of Dance includes all needed accessories: headpieces, tights, etc. We try to make your job as easy as possible, just provide a body and shoes. If your child is taking more than 2 hours of class per week, your balance below reflects the final amount due for your child's costumes.
